The No Child Left Behind (NCLB) federal law requires those teachers teaching core academic classes to meet a specific federal definition of "Highly Qualified." Pegasus works very hard to ensure that the teachers in our core classes meet this definition.

Ms. Mitchell, Music Teacher for 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades, has a Bachelor's degree in music from Southern Methodist University and comes to Pegasus with 5 years of teaching music in a private school. To be considered highly qualified for 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grades under the federal rules, she also needed to pass a specialized test. While she had not taken that test before the start of the school year, causing her to not meet the definition of highly qualified for a period of time, we are pleased to inform you that as of October 15, 2010, Ms. Mitchell has taken and passed that test and meets all of the requirements and is now "Highly Qualified" in accordance with the federal definition for all Pegasus grades. She was already highly qualified for teaching grades 7 through 12.
